Catholicism 101: Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC) 2041: "The precepts of the Church are set in the context of a moral life bound to and nourished by liturgical life. The obligatory character of these positive laws decreed by the pastoral authorities is meant to guarantee to the faithful the very necessary minimum in the spirit of prayer and moral effort, in the growth in love of God and neighbor."

Being a faithful Catholic entails more than merely believing what the Church teaches and trying to follow Her moral teachings. That is obviously essential, but it is not the whole picture. Being a faithful Catholic also entails participating in the life of the Church, the household of God, as St. Paul says (1 Tim 3:15). The Church, exercising the power to bind and loose given Her by Jesus (Mt 16:19), makes explicit the minimum requirements for Catholics to be in good standing with the Church.

Over the next few weeks, I will be sharing passages from the Catechism on the 5 Precepts of the Church.
