Pastor Notes

Trinity 101: A few weeks ago I gave an outline of our basic belief regarding the Most Holy Trinity. Here it is in writing.

1. There is only One God.

- a. God is eternal, a pure spirit, infinite in His being and perfection, all knowing, all good, all loving, all present. He is the source of all that exists and He holds everything in existence.

2. The One God exists as Three Divine Persons.

- a. The 1st Person is the Father, the 2nd Person is the Son, and the 3rd Person is the Holy Spirit.

3. Each of the Three Divine Persons is fully God.

- a. The Father is 100% God, the Son is 100% God, and the Holy Spirit is 100% God. They together possess the One Divine Nature.

4. Each of the Three Divine Persons are truly distinct from one another.

- a. The Father is not the Son, the Son is not the Father, and neither Father nor Son is the Holy Spirit. From all eternity they are Three Distinct Persons, united in the One Godhead.

If you want to go into more depth with this mystery of our faith, I recommend reading “The Trinity: How Not to Be a Heretic” by Stephen Bullivant.
