Notes from the Pastor

January 1st Masses: Jan 1 is a holy day of obligation for the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God. St. John's Masses will be December 31st at 5:30 pm and January 1st at 10:30 am. St. Mary's Mass will be January 1st at 8:30 am.

Catholicism 101: The dogma of Mary as Mother of God was defined by the Council of Ephesus in 431. It was actually proclaimed by the Church in order to defend what we believe about Jesus, which is true of all Marian dogmas. There was a heretic named Nestorius preaching that there was a human Jesus and a divine Jesus and that Mary was only the mother of the human Jesus. In order to combat this heresy, the Church officially clarified that Jesus is one Person, a divine Person, with a human nature, and because Mary gave birth to Jesus, who is truly God Incarnate, it is right and true to call Mary the Mother of God. However, this does not mean that Mary is the mother of God the Father or God the Holy Spirit, nor is she the mother of the eternal Divine Nature, but rather she became the Mother of God the Son when He was conceived in her womb as a true man.
